Academy Requirements

- Applicants must be ages 13-18 & enrolled in high school at the time of the Academy.
- Applicants must have a minimum "C" grade point average (3.0)



Through first-hand experience JPA Cadets learn what all is involved in a career in Law Enforcement.

- Applicants must not have been arrested or referred to juvenile probations for any crime.
- Applicants must have a medical release indicating ability to participate in physical activities.
- A complete background check will be conducted on each applicant and selection will be made based on outcome and references.
- Participation is limited to 25 cadets.
